# God's Ways are Higher – Victor Gonzales with Our Lord in Heaven



Grace Ministries members have joined many more have been praying for the Lord to heal Victor Gonzales. We praised the Lord for how Victor celebrated life and inspired many with his faith while patiently waiting for healing, most recently from organ transplant operations in Indianapolis. Prayers were answered – in God's way.

Victor went home to be with the Lord in February. Grace Ministries Lead Pastor Bert Woodburn joined his family and girlfriend in the hospital before his death. "He was loved by so many. Victor glorified God with his life," Bert said. "He is no longer in pain and is rejoicing with his savior in heaven. We were blessed to have him in our lives."

Given only a whisper of a chance to survive a horrifying workplace accident in 2018 while he was installing storm drain pipes. He was airlifted by helicopter to a hospital and underwent five surgeries in the first week. An initial transplant surgery gave him the ability to supplement and IV diet by eating and drinking again. Last year, he continued physical therapy, walking on a prosthetic leg, driving a car, and attending Bible study meetings.

The 23-year-old moved to Indianapolis in November 2019 to await a transplant at one of the world's leading transplant hospitals. Earlier this year, he underwent surgery for organ transplants for his stomach, small intestine, pancreas and liver.

Before the injury, he played high school soccer at Franklinton High School coached by Bert, who was also Victor's youth pastor at Red Oak Baptist Church. Last fall, Victor attended a soccer game as an honorary assistant coach. He was presented with his original soccer jersey from his freshman year and shared his testimony at halftime.
