With grocery prices up from a year ago, the cost of buying a Thanksgiving meal is hitting families a lot harder this year. Despite inflation and rising food costs, Grace Ministries was able to provide over 50 turkeys or chickens and all the fixings for a Thanksgiving dinner. These meals

were distributed to families in need through a church in Wake Forest, NC, a local high school food ministry, and a church in Louisburg, NC.

For Grace Ministries was able to purchase and provide Thanksgiving dinners to those that otherwise would not have had one and then to do it all in two weeks," stated Pastor Bert Woodburn, President of Grace Ministries. One individual who attends a Grace Ministries Bible study donated a \$100 grocery gift card to buy turkeys. This then challenged others who attend the numerous Grace Ministry Bible studies along with ministry board members to match and/or add to that donation. "This is just a beginning for we hope next year to triple the number of meals we can donate," commented Woodburn.





### Legacy Soccer Jamboree

Grace Ministries sponsored the Legacy Men's Soccer Jamboree that was held at Franklinton High School, Franklinton, NC this past August. The Jamboree is a men's soccer tournament held in honor of 5 local high school soccer alumni who have passed away. There were 15 teams from around the state of North Carolina participating in the jamboree.

This is an all-day event that gives athletes the ability to compete on a state level while

This past September Grace Ministries held an outdoor gun safety class for American Heritage Girls Troop NC 4673. The event was hosted by Grace Ministries board member Sue Meehan and her husband Mike Meehan at their North Carolina farm. There were 40 participants, middle to high-school-age girls and their parents. The girls were earning a gun safety badge as part of their American Heritage Girls program. American Heritage Girls (AHG) is a Christ-centered character and leadership development program for girls 5 to 18 years of age. AHG is dedicated to the mission of building women of integrity through service to God, family, community, and country.
