A Faithful Presence in Times of Need

Over the past month, Grace Cares, an outreach of Grace Ministries USA, has continued to serve individuals and families facing difficult and often unexpected circumstances. Through the faithful support of donors and volunteers, care has been extended in ways that meet both practical needs and matters of the heart.

Families experiencing food insecurity received deliveries during urgent moments of need. One family received essential furnishings as they stepped into stable housing for the first time, turning an empty house into a home. A woman with limited mobility was supported through yard care and the restoration of working heating and cooling in her home. Others, including women

and children in vulnerable situations, were provided with clothing and necessary supplies. Families walking through the loss of loved ones were met with compassion, practical help, and prayer.

In other instances, timely financial assistance helped prevent families from facing eviction and losing electricity. In each situation, the desire has been to live out Galatians 6:2 "Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ." Each act of service, no matter how small becomes a part of a larger testimony of God's provision and love.

These efforts are made possible through the generosity of those who give and serve. Needs

often arise without warning, and continued support allows Grace Cares to respond quickly and faithfully. Hebrews 13:16 reminds us, "do not forget to do good and to share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased."
