Loving Our Neighbors This Easter

Saturday, March 28th, was a joyful and busy day for Grace Ministries USA. We had the privilege of participating in two major outreach events in Franklin County: an Easter egg hunt at Faith Baptist Church in Youngsville, and an Easter food distribution in Louisburg, NC. Through both events, we were able to share the Gospel and invest in the lives of our community members.

The Easter food distribution was a beautiful example of the Body of Christ in action. Several denominations came together with one purpose, to love our neighbors and share the Good News of Jesus Christ. Over 200 families were served during this event, each one receiving food, prayer, encouragement, and the hope found in Christ.

The Easter egg hunt was also a tremendous success. With beautiful weather and an atmosphere full of joy, more than 400 children attended and eagerly collected over 10,000 Easter eggs scattered across the grounds. We were blessed to give out over 200 cross necklaces and, even more importantly, to pray with families and share the message of the Gospel.

On April 1st, Grace Cares, in conjunction with Community Cares, had the opportunity to pack 190 bags of food for children in Franklin County facing homelessness. These bags helped families provide meals during spring break, a somewhat scary time for families when school resources

are not available and food can be limited. Each bag provides up to 10 days of supplemental food for these children. The ladies of our Young Pros group not only helped pack the bags, but also handmade Easter cards for each family, complete with a Bible verse and a personal message of hope and encouragement. We are deeply grateful for the generous donations that made this outreach possible. Without your support either financially or with the Handful of Rice initiative, efforts like these and the ability to serve these families would not be possible.

Moments like these remind us

of the power of coming together in faith to love and serve our community. "Let your light shine before others, so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father who is in heaven." Matthew 5:16. We are grateful for every opportunity presented that allows us to point others to Christ.
